## Collections

Sidebar (Left Column) - Collections List

- This will be a vertical navigation section on the left.
  - o Position: Fixed or sticky so that it's always visible while scrolling.
  - Width: Typically around 250px to 300px.
  - o **Background Color:** Light or dark depending on the overall theme.
  - Content:
    - Title: "Collections"
    - List of Collections:
      - Each collection can be shown as a clickable list item.

# **Book Details Page**

Sidebar (Left Column) - List of Chapters

- **Position:** Fixed or sticky so it remains visible while scrolling through chapters.
